Dr. Naus will outline the cycle of activities and focus on the issues arising around 'mandatory' immunization or documentation of immunization. She will also discuss immunization program planning, delivery and the evaluation process.

Dr. Naus is the Medical Director of the Communicable Diseases & Immunization Service at BCDC. She is also a Professor in the UBC School of Population & Public Health.

Dr. Naus' clinical and research interests include planning and evaluation of old and new immunization policy and programs, various aspects of vaccine preventable diseases and implications for future control in the context of immunization, immunization registries, determinants of vaccine uptake and vaccine safety.

Dr. Naus' career in public health has been focused on communicable disease prevention and control. Before joining BCCDC in July 2001, she was the provincial epidemiologist in Ontario from 1997 - 2001 and a senior medical consultant in vaccine preventable diseases and TB control for the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care from 1990 - 1997. Dr. Naus has been active in immunization at the national level, including on the Canadian National Advisory Committee on Immunization and is a member of several NACI expert groups. She is active on the Canadian Immunization Committee, Canadian Immunization Registries and Coverage Network, Automated Identification of Vaccine Products Working Group, Canadian Immunization Research Network and other national and provincial committees. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada and of the American College of Preventive Medicine
