### IS A PARALLEL PRIVATE MEDICAL CARE SYSTEM THE ANSWER?

**Guest Speaker – Dr. Brian Day, MRCP (UK), FRCS (Eng), FRCS (C)**

Dr. Day will speak on the practical and ethical implications of integration of private medicine within the public system. He will address the potential liability a physician might face who fails to advise patients of the availability of private services and what pitfalls might arise from 'pushing' patients into the private path.

Dr. Brian Day is an orthopaedic surgeon and health researcher in Canada and a Past President of Canadian Medical Association. He is the founder and Medical Director of the private clinic, the Cambie Surgery Centre and Specialist Referral Centre in Vancouver. Dr. Day is a spokesperson for the high-profile, multi-year and ongoing lawsuit against the provincial government, *Cambie Surgeries Corporation v. British Columbia (Medical Services Commission)*, otherwise known as "The Day Case".
