THE TREATING PHYSICIAN AS AN EXPERT WITNESS

Guest Speaker – The Honourable Mr. Justice Nathan Smith

The Honourable Mr. Justice Smith was appointed to the Supreme Court of British Columbia on May 19, 2005. Prior to his appointment to the Bench, his legal practice focused on medical malpractice litigation.

Mr. Justice Smith's 2011 decision in *Edmondson v. Payer* on the admissibility and use of clinical records and expert opinion evidence has been cited a remarkable 92 times in the courts. Judge Smith will speak on the treating physician as an expert witness, highlighting the fundamental distinction between fact and opinion evidence.
