Dr. Mehta graduated from Tufts University School of Dental Medicine in Boston and completed a Hospital Dentistry Residency where he was Chief Resident at the Greater Los Angeles Veterans Affairs Medical Centre. He then completed additional residency training at UCLA Medical Centre and the School of Dentistry's Department of Oral Medicine and Orofacial Pain. Dr. Mehta has taught at UBC and continues to lecture to UBC pharmacy students. He has provided expert opinions for both plaintiffs and defendants and has been an expert witness in BC since 2003.

Dr. Mehta will address the delayed recognition and diagnosis of neuropathic pain to the face and mouth.

Dr. Chiku Verma is a 1994 graduate of Northwestern University and completed a two year General Practice/Hospital Residency at Ohio State University in 1996 and stayed on as a clinical instructor while practicing full time in Columbus, Ohio. He has been practicing full time general private practice for over 17 years in Langley with a comprehensive multidisciplinary approach to treating patients. He is a Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry and has served on both boards of the College of Dental Surgeons and Association of BC Dentists.

Dr. Verma will provide a perspective on how the history of trauma to the oral structure can influence future treatment.

Dr. Tejani graduated from the University of Bristol in 1984 and worked in general practice in England for 6 years before qualifying in Canada in 1999. Dr. Tejani has studied with leading members of the profession in the field of cosmetics, temporomandibular joint dysfunction and occlusion, full mouth reconstruction, implants and orthodontics from England, Italy, Sweden, Switzerland the USA and Canada. He has practices in Vancouver and London, England.

Dr. Tejani will provide a perspective on delayed presentation of TMJ disorder following trauma and how it may be treated.
