### NAVIGATING THE "MINOR INJURY" LEGISLATION AND REGULATIONS: A PRIMER FOR MEDICAL AND LEGAL PROFESSIONALS

Nicholas Peterson is a lawyer, currently practicing at Collins Peterson LLP – Injury Lawyers.

Nick's presentation concerns the changes the government recently introduced in May and November 2018 concerning what the new laws classify as a "minor injury" for ICBC injury claimants following motor vehicle collisions.

Discussion will surround the types of injuries caught by this new scheme which include brain injuries, chronic pain syndromes and psychological/psychiatric conditions, short of rendering one incapacitated; how pain and suffering compensation for such injuries is capped at \$5,500; and how these minor injury determinations are dealt with exclusively by the new Civil Resolution Tribunal created by the government and not by the courts.

Nick graduated from the University of Alberta Faculty of Law, followed by a clerkship for six Justices of the Supreme Court of BC. On his call to the Bar, Nick practiced at a national law firm in Vancouver before deciding to work exclusively for injured people.

Nick currently serves on the Board of Governors for TLABC having previously served on TLABC's Executive. Nick also volunteers with the Law Society of B.C. as a contributor to the PLTC bar admission course's civil practice materials.
