PROTECTING YOUR PRIMARY RELATIONSHIP

GUEST SPEAKER— DR. GORDON COCHRANE

Dr. Cochrane will discuss the characteristics of a primary relationship with an emphasis on how medical and legal professionals can protect their relationships from the pressures of their careers. He will provide examples in terms of the professional communication style that is effective at work but which is considerably less effective at home. He will also share some practical, clinically proven tools to assist couples to effectively deal with current and historic relationship impediments.
