The Honourable Brown is an Arbitrator, Mediator and Associate Counsel at Hunter Litigation. His career began as counsel handling a wide range of commercial, insurance, construction, estates and other litigation. He served as Professor and Associate Dean of Law at the University of Alberta, Chair of the Health Law Institute and Chair of the University Appeals Board. He then served over 10 years on Canada's federal judiciary, including eight years on the Supreme Court of Canada, where he wrote significant judgments in commercial and private law (both common law and civil law), constitutional law, administrative law, aboriginal law, oil and gas, tax law, technology law, criminal law and class actions.

Mr. Brown is a text author in relation to economic loss and government liability and has over 40 published law review articles. Mr. Brown holds degrees from the Universities of British Columbia, Victoria and Toronto, including an earned Master's and Doctoral degree from Toronto. He is a recipient from the Lieutenant-Governor of Alberta of the Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal "in recognition of significant contributions to the province".
