DR. MARK TYNDALL, MD, SCD, FRCPC

SMOKE AND MIRRORS

Dr. Tyndall is a public health expert and independent consultant and was formerly a Professor of Medicine at the University of British Columbia. He has served as the Executive Director of the BC Center for Disease Control, deputy Provincial Health Officer for British Columbia, Head of Infectious Diseases at St. Paul's Hospital, Vancouver and the University of Ottawa, and Program Director for Epidemiology at the BC Centre for Excellence in HIV/AIDS. His career awards include the Medical Research Council Research Fellowship, Michael Smith Foundation for Health Research Senior Scholar Award, and the Ontario HIV Treatment Network Applied Research Chair. He has authored over 250 peer-reviewed academic publications, with a focus on HIV care and prevention, harm reduction, and public health intervention research.

Dr. Tyndall received his medical degree and Internal Medicine training at McMaster University and his Infectious Diseases fellowship training at the University of Manitoba. He received a Doctoral Degree in Epidemiology from The School of Public Health at Harvard University with a focus on health and human rights.

Dr. Tyndall is a prominent voice in tobacco harm reduction and will be speaking on this topic as author of the recent book *Vaping: Behind the Smoke and Fears*, which challenges misconceptions about nicotine.
